

God – The Father

As a member of the Trinity, God the Father is one with, co-equal to, co-**eternal**, and consubstantial with the Son and the Holy Spirit, each Person being the **one eternal God** and in no way separated: all alike are uncreated and omnipotent. Because of this, the Trinity is beyond reason and can only be known by revelation.

The Word Theos is Greek , meaning God. Therefore, theology is the study of God. Before anything came into being, He was, and is and shall always be. He is from everlasting to everlasting- has no beginning and no ending.

Everything must have a beginning and an ending. Not with God! He created the seasons, years and days. “In the beginning (no one knows when that was) God created the Heaven and the earth.

The existence of God is within himself. He is Self-existent. He caused us to be, not nothing caused Him to be. He always was and ever shall be God. God the Father is the creator of man, but only the Father of those who have accepted His Son (Jesus). The supernatural birth causes a person to be a son.—and if a son, then a heir of God through Christ: (Gal 4:7).

He is a spiritual son of Abraham – blessed through Abraham according to the Promise. (Gen 12:1-3)

Rom 5:12 ¹² Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

Rom 5:17-19 ¹⁷ For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)¹⁸ Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

Rom 3:10 ¹⁰ As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

Rom 3:23-26 ²³ For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;²⁴ Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:²⁵ Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;²⁶ To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

1st Cor 15:22 – As in Adam all die, even so in Christ shall all be made alive.
