Sunday School Lesson #7

What does this mean? A child always has the nature of his father. The nature of the Adamic race is sinful. All of us are born with the Adamic nature. So, by natural birth we are sinful and we serve sin and Satan.

When we accept Jesus, the Son, as our Redeemer, we experience the new birth- the supernatural birth- once identified with Adam but now identified with Christ Jesus.

Rom 5:12 ¹² Wherefore, as by one man sin entered into the world, and death by sin; and so death passed upon all men, for that all have sinned:

Rom 5:17-19 ¹⁷ For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness shall reign in life by one, Jesus Christ.)¹⁸ Therefore as by the offence of one judgment came upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one the free gift came upon all men unto justification of life.¹⁹ For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so by the obedience of one shall many be made righteous.

Rom 3:10 ¹⁰ As it is written, There is none righteous, no, not one:

Rom 3:23-26 ²³ For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God;²⁴ Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:²⁵ Whom God hath set forth to be a propitiation through faith in his blood, to declare his righteousness for the remission of sins that are past, through the forbearance of God;²⁶ To declare, I say, at this time his righteousness: that he might be just, and the justifier of him which believeth in Jesus.

You however must be grounded and established in what you believe about Jesus. Your salvations depends upon it.

Jesus was 100% human and 100% Divine. However, in order to die, he had to become a man. He voluntarily came down here without his Godly powers. He emptied himself of those powers and laid them aside. The miracles he performed came as a result of him being empowered and anointed by the Holy Ghost/ Holy Spirit. Likewise Jesus says to us to do His works (John 14:12) under the anointing and the same power He had, the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:8).
