Lesson 9:

Soteriology- The Study of Salvation

Salvation, in [religion](#) is the deliverance of humankind from such fundamentally negative or disabling conditions as suffering, evil, finitude, and death. It also entails the restoration or a raising up ones many different conditions to a higher realm or state. Salvation is a characteristic related to an issue of profound human concern.

The fundamental idea contained in the English word *salvation*, and the Latin *salvatio* and Greek *sōtēria* from which it derives, is that of saving or delivering.

Salvation is the act or state of preserving and being preserved from harm. It's Christianity's deliverance from the power of sin, sickness, eternal death and from the penalties ensuing from it.

Because Adam disobeyed God in the garden and ate of the forbidden tree, man lost fellowship with God and the sin nature came upon him. They were then cursed with spiritual death, a spiritual separation from their creator and unable to understand anything spiritual. Therefore every man born into the world are born after the likeness of Adam in this respect. Rom 3:23 says **For all have sinned**, and come short of the glory of God. Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat **a son in his own likeness, after his image**; and called his name Seth. Sin became the curse of all mankind when he is born. **(Gen 5:3)**. But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness unto him; neither can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned. 1st Cor 2:14,

Key Points:

1) All of the sin offerings , offense and guilt sacrifices foreshadowed the sacrifice of Jesus , the sinless lamb

2) Man was made in God's image (Gen 1:26). He disobeyed God and ate from the tree of the knowledge of Good and Evil.

3) Eating of this Tree meant man had to take on a sin nature and experience the life heartache, pain and eternal damnation.

4) God in eternity past had already prepared a way to redeem man and bring him back into perfect relationship with Him.

5) God sent Jesus to die on the cross to pay the penalty of all of our sin.

6) 1st Pet 2:21,22 Jesus gave his life as a sacrifice , even though he was righteous.

7) He did die on the cross and his blood was shed for the remission of sin. He went to hell and rose from the dead. He took the keys of death, hell and the grave, triumphantly appeasing God and fulfilling all he said concerning the resurrection.

Salvation Prayer- Dear God, I come to you, recognizing that I am a sinner, in need of Salvation. I come today to acknowledge you Lord Jesus as my Lord and personal Savior. I repent of every sin , I have committed and I chose to change and live for you God. I thank you for complete forgiveness . I believe that Jesus died, was buried and on the third day He rose from the dead. According to your word Lord, you said if I would confess with my mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in my heart that God raised him from the dead, then I would be saved. Thank you Lord got receiving me as your child in Jesus name Amen.

Assurance of Salvation Prayer

Lord I come and thank you that I have received you as my Lord and Savior. I thank you that according o your word Rom 10:9,10 ,If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead , thou shalt be saved. Lord I thank you that I am saved. Your word also says that you would not let no one pluck me out of your hands (John 10:28). Thank you that I am sure that I am saved, no matter how I may feel.

Restoration to Fellowship- their standing was intact but the fellowship was broken. (Is 58:2)

Heaven Father- I know as I come to you, you will in no wise cast me out. I thank you that you still love me. You have never left me or forsaken me. Lord I am your child because I believe that you raised Jesus from the dead and that He is my Lord and Savior. I confess all of my sin right now Jesus, please forgive me and cleanse me from all of my unrighteousness. I thank you now that I am forgiven by faith Lord and that I am back into right fellowship with you in Jesus name.

Salvation (ABC's)

A-Acknowledge they are a sinner in need of a savior/ask for forgiveness

B-Believe that Jesus died on the cross and God rose him from the dead

C-Confess with their mouth openly that Jesus is their Lord and Savior

If you were to die tonight will heaven be your home? If they say yes then ask how do they know? If they say I don't know or no, then proceed to tell or show them what John 3:16/Romans 10:9-10 says.

John 3:16-18 (kjv) 16.For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life. 17 For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved. **18** He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

Romans 10:9-10 (kjv) 9 That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. 10 For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Please bow your head and repeat this prayer after me:

Heavenly Father, I acknowledge that I am a sinner and I need to be saved. I am asking Jesus Christ to come into my heart and be my Lord and Savior. Lord please forgive me of my sins. I believe in my heart that Jesus died on the cross and God raised him from the dead. Thank you Lord for making me the person you want me to be. I am now your child. If I die tonight, heaven will be my home. In Jesus name, Amen.
