Angels

Do Angels exist? The bible clearly teaches that these spirit beings exist.

Ps 148:1-5 kj Praise ye the LORD. Praise ye the LORD from the heavens: praise him in the heights.² Praise ye him, all his angels: praise ye him, all his hosts.³ Praise ye him, sun and moon: praise him, all ye stars of light.⁴ Praise him, ye heavens of heavens, and ye waters that be above the heavens.⁵ Let them praise the name of the LORD: **for he commanded, and they were created.**

God created each of the Angelic beings. This creation did not involve a female and a male so they could procreate.

1st Pet 1:10-12 esv Concerning this salvation, the prophets who prophesied about the grace that was to be yours searched and inquired carefully, ¹¹ inquiring what person or time^[a] the Spirit of Christ in them was indicating when he predicted the sufferings of Christ and the subsequent glories. ¹² It was revealed to them that they were serving not themselves but you, in the things that have now been announced to you through those who preached the good news to you by the Holy Spirit sent from heaven, things into which angels long to look.

- 1) Rev 7:10 They are called upon to worship God.
- 2) Angels personality consist of intellect, emotion and will.
- 3) Angels were created by God so they could serve Him, praise Him, worship Him and exalt Him. (John 1:1-3)
- 4) They are called messengers of God, God's ministering Spirits. (Heb 1:14)
- 5) They are great in number. (Rev 5:11)
- 6) They exist in multitudes__ When the Shepard's were told about the birth of Jesus, Luke 2:13 kj - we are told there were a multitude of heavenly Host praising God and singing "Glory to God in the highest and on earth peace , good will toward men".
- 7) Jesus said on one occasion that if He wanted too , He could call legions of Angels to assist him in His defense. A legion in Bible times consisted of three to six thousand Angels.
- 8) Angels are unmarriageable beings. This mean they do not marry and they are not given in marriage.
- 9)_Luke 20:36 says Angels do not die.
- 10) Generally these beings are invisible to the human eye. There are times however when the Holy Spirit will illuminate one eyes to actually see Angels.

Is 6:1-3 kj In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the LORD sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple.² Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.³ And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

1) **Daniel 4:13 Kj** Angels are called Watchers

2) Lucifer who is now called Satan. Sin was found in Him and He was banished and cast out of Heaven forever.

Isaiah 14:12-14 kj ¹² How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! how art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!¹³ For thou hast said in thine heart, I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God: I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north:

¹⁴ I will ascend above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the most High.¹⁵ Yet thou shalt be brought down to hell, to the sides of the pit.¹⁶ They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;

3) Michael is spoken about in Daniel 12 entirety .

4) Michael is associated with making great announcements of great impending events.

5) Gabriel is the leader of holy messenger Angels.

6) Cherubim Angels- these were also placed in the Garden of Eden to keep Adam and Eve from returning because of their disobedience. They are those in charge of protecting the throne of God. They protect God's Holiness.

7) Seraphim Angels are always seen in scripture as worshipping God. It's said each time they bow and rise up they see something different about God. They continually say Holy Holy Holy is the Lord of Host, the whole earth is full of His glory.

8) 1 Tim 5:21 Paul refers to Angels as Holy Ones and those involved in the election of those convicted and drawn to Jesus for Salvation.

9) Angels that followed Satan in his rebellion and what's considered general Angels. They have become demons. They were tested and were confirmed in their wickedness. But those that did not follow Satan are called Holy Angels.

10) Angels are to ever be never be compared with God. They are creatures created by the Almighty.

11) Angels are never to be worship. We are to never bow down before there.

Rev 22:5-9 kj ⁵ And there shall be no night there; and they need no candle, neither light of the sun; for the Lord God giveth them light: and they shall reign for ever and ever.⁶ And he said unto me, These sayings are faithful and true: and the Lord God of the holy prophets sent his angel to shew unto his servants the things which must shortly be done.⁷ Behold, I come quickly: blessed is he that keepeth the sayings of the prophecy of this book.

⁸ And I John saw these things, and heard them. And when I had heard and seen, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel which shewed me these things.⁹ Then saith he unto me, See thou do it not: for I am thy fellowservant, and of thy brethren the prophets, and of them which keep the sayings of this book: worship God.

12) Angels are very powerful creatures but they are not omnipotent like God.

13) II King 19:35 Kj *On one occasion one Angel was sent to handle some issues:*

And it came to pass that night, that the angel of the LORD went out and smote in the camp of the Assyrians a hundred fourscore and five thousand; and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they were all dead corpses. (185,000)

14) Jesus Christ is completely superior to all the Angelic Host. He is said to be the commander of the Angel Army.

Heb 1:5-14 kj ⁵ *For unto which of the angels said he at any time, Thou art my Son, this day have I begotten thee? And again, I will be to him a Father, and he shall be to me a Son?*⁶ *And again, when he bringeth in the first begotten into the world, he saith, And let all the angels of God worship him.*

⁷ *And of the angels he saith, Who maketh his angels spirits, and his ministers a flame of fire.*⁸ *But unto the Son he saith, Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: a sceptre of righteousness is the sceptre of thy kingdom.*⁹ *Thou hast loved righteousness, and hated iniquity; therefore God, even thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.*¹⁰ *And, Thou, Lord, in the beginning hast laid the foundation of the earth; and the heavens are the works of thine hands:*¹¹ *They shall perish; but thou remainest; and they all shall wax old as doth a garment;*¹² *And as a vesture shalt thou fold them up, and they shall be changed: but thou art the same, and thy years shall not fail.*¹³ *But to which of the angels said he at any time, Sit on my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool?*¹⁴ *Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation?*

15) Phil 2:9-11 kj

16) In the future according to **1st Cor 6:3** the redeemed of God will judge Angels.

17) The Angels in Heaven are learning about God's wisdom by observing the actions of the church. **Eph 3:9,10kj**

18) In Revelations the Angels will be used to carry out the judgement of God upon the world and the unbelieving.

19) God's Angels will be used in the tribulation Period to control the forces of nature.

20) Gal 3:19 Angels were involved in giving the law to Moses.

21) They were present at the first announcement of Jesus' birth.

22) They were very active in the early life of the Church.

23) They were active in opening prison doors and delivering God's Leaders.

24) The Angel of God moved the stone away from the tomb that Jesus was buried in.

25) The Angel of God warned Joseph to take the child down to Egypt to avoid the murderous attempts of Herod.

26) Angels came and ministered to Jesus at the Garden of Gethsemane. This was to help him as He knew this was the night He would be betrayed and taken by the soldiers.

27) **Luke 15:10 kj** ¹⁰ Likewise, I say unto you, there is joy in the presence of the angels of God over one sinner that repenteth.

Gabriel -His name means Strength of God- this seems to be God’s prophetic Angel. The messenger and interpreter of God’s prophetic words concerning Christ. (Dan 8:16-19; 9:1-27; 10:8-11; Luke 1:19,26)

Some writers suggest that each of these three Archangels had a third of the Angels under their authority,
