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**Appease** – means God was satisfied with the payment of sin. Jesus's blood was the appeasement of our sins.

All the benefits and provisions of Christ dying on the cross for us are directly related to the Blood of Jesus.

When we quote any scripture, it is directly connected with the (Blood).

Therefore, when we really understand this awesome blessing, our faith can certainly soar to greater and greater heights. The blood becomes a solid foundation for developing powerful faith.

**(1st Cor 11:25)** As we commemorate the sacred rite of Communion, we are to remember his shed blood for the redemption of all mankind.

The time of reflecting on all Jesus suffered for you and me. A time of great worship, honor, unity in the body, renewing, forgiveness, intimacy, and enjoying the Lord's awesome Presence.

We take the bread – to remember his body, being broken, on the way of the Cross (Via Delarosa) – we are healed by his stripes- **1st Pet 2:24**<sup>24</sup> Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. **Is 53:5 kj** <sup>5</sup> But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.

As a future blessing, Jesus's blood paved the way for eternal life.

Because of the Blood however- we are redeemed ,rescued, bought back , healed, cleansed, and sanctified. (Eph 1:7)

***Therefore we are to plead the blood daily over what concerns us- God will perfect those things that concern us.***

**The Church** – protects against stagnation or resistance against the vision, the families, members, growth, etc.

**Our Spouse**- eliminate arguments, harshness, hatred, offense, heartache, eliminate covenant breaking, turmoil, sickness, etc.

**Children**- protection when away from home, at school, situations that may arise at school, illuminates and brings understanding and ability to your child's mind. Protection from gangs and bullies.

**Relatives** Family salvation, destroys the spiritual blindness and mental clutches of the enemy over your family members.

*You can use the Blood of Jesus against personal character flaws such as prejudice, jealousy, hatred, fear, argumentative spirits in your home and on the job; against people that threaten your safety, against bad habits, Gambling, Cussing (devils language) , lusting ( pornography) and against the spirit of death; as when the Death angel could not touch those in the land of Goshen that had placed the Blood of the Lamb on the lintel and the side post of their homes.*

**Phil 2:9-11 Kj** <sup>9</sup> Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:<sup>10</sup> That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;<sup>11</sup> And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

**In John 16:33** Jesus made it clear- <sup>33</sup> These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. In the world ye shall have tribulation: but be of good cheer; I have overcome the world.

## **How? By the use of His Blood !!!!**

It is a promise from God- As the Blood of Jesus twinkled down the cross , the New Covenant(Promise, Agreement) was divinely established.

## God's Plan for Healing

### *Jehovah Raphe – the Lord that healeth thee*

By turning away from God in disobedience, man lost the blessing and protection of God, and came under a curse and the power of the devil. In this way, the devil was able to bring upon man's body many forms of pain, weakness and sickness. However, God in His mercy still desired to bless man, and to save him, not only from sin, but also from sickness. For this reason Christ on the cross bore not only our sins, but also our sickness. Therefore, by faith in Christ we may now receive physical healing for our bodies, as well as forgiveness and peace for our souls.

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## **God's Plan for Healing our Bodies**

Healing for our bodies from God comes to us through hearing and believing God's Word, and allowing God's Spirit **to fill our bodies with the Resurrection Life of Christ**.
