

True Leadership

As born-again believers, as born leaders we already have the capacity, inherent desire, natural talents, potential and abilities to correspond to being a leader. God does not demand from a product what it cannot do. God was not just speaking to Adam to be the leader of the church for the world but to every seed that was in his loins. God's awesome intent was to share his rulership and his administration of creation with humanity. We were designed to reflect God's attributes and his characteristics as it relates to true leadership.

1. God doesn't have the dominion, he is Dominion.
2. God doesn't have authority, he is Authority.
3. God doesn't have love, he is Love.
4. God doesn't have glory oh, he is Glory.
5. God doesn't possess leadership, he is Leadership.

Therefore, the Godly man or woman inherits these attributes and God the Creator, is the (only) leading maker of True Leadership.

1. Being designed to be leaders means that we are ordained to be one.
2. We are leaders by nature, whether we manifest it or not.
3. The desire to lead and achieve greatness lies in every human heart passionately and silently.
4. If you want to become a great leader, be a great sermon. This is the main secret of greatness. Matt 20:28 ; Mark 10:45
5. Whatever your gift and assignment is; if you want to be great, serve it to all mankind.
6. Don't seek greatness, but seek to serve your gift to the maximum and you will become sought-after. This way you become valuable to others. Never find yourself boasting about your services or ministry. Let others encourage and boast about you. I never go around trying to make people acknowledge my gifting. Never go around trying to find a place to preach or teach; let others invite you; let them open the door. Our job is to continue to seek God, learn of him,

obey his word, conform to His image, serve at your local church, stay humble and the doors will open by God himself and your timing to go forth will be perfect. Luke 16:12 kj If you are or have been faithful in that which is another man's, who shall give you that which is your own? Phil 2:7-10 kj But made himself of no reputation, and took upon himself the form of a servant, and was made in the likeness of men, 8) and being found in fashion as a man, he humbled himself, and became obedient unto death, even the death of the cross.9) wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name, 10) that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven and things in the earth, and things under the earth; 11) And that every tongue shall confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

7. When you lead effectively , then people will call you a leader.
8. All True Leaders are simply glorified servants for the benefit of others.
9. Jesus, the greatest leader, said “ the son of man came not to be served, but to serve and to give his life for a ransom for a many (Mark 10:45”).
10. Servants exist for the world, we are all servants to this world. Paul says being then made free from sin, he became the Servants of righteousness (Rom 6:18 kj).

What is your purpose? Your purpose will be enclosed with your passion, your inclinations, your likes, your talents and your natural abilities. This is all part of your divine design.

These are areas that you are supposed to have dominion in. This is your domain. People are waiting to be blessed with your gift. God want to use you to answer many prayers . Now focus and get perfectly prepared to lead through your service.

Every human being has a seed of greatness buried in a gift needed by the world. Your gift is a miracle for this world.

We must be trained and prepared to serve one's gift to the world at every opportunity for the overall betterment of humanity.

Your service, your assignments and your ministry are correctly identified as your self-distribution to your generation, the maximization of your self-manifestation and the pursuit of your inherent vision by God.

The Natural results of True Leadership

1. True leadership is displayed in genuine confidence based on one's natural and spiritual abilities, enabled, anointed and **guided** by God, his creator.
2. The true leader will experience genuine confidence, personal fulfillment and great satisfaction in leading with a holy and righteous heart. (He will not be perfect in all things, all the time. But he will be perfect in many). (1st John 1:9, Prov 28:13)
3. A true leader is not one with a competitive spirit because he is **secure** in his own uniqueness. **He has the ability to enjoy the gifts and talents of all of his brothers and sisters.**
4. The true leader is not one to compare himself with no one else at any time. He knows for a fact that he is completely secure in who God made him to be. He knows that there's only one person like him and nobody can beat him, being himself. He or she knows that he is ordained to be in this generation for such a time as this. He knows that his gifts and talents, **perfected, skilled and refined** will result in miracles for the world.
5. The true leader will never allow jealousy to take root in his spirit because of another person's gifts or values.
6. The true leader has a sense of intrinsic value based on the Word of God and the knowledge of his significance.
7. True leaders won't be like the so-called leaders that parade in our communities that are entangled with being power-hungry, insecure and unqualified.

8. A true leader is a good manager. He is also one that has a good self concept of himself, a strong self-worth, and a high self-esteem level to compensate for his feelings of inferiority and vulnerability. He will not intimidate, manipulate or oppress anyone.
9. A true leader knows, no matter how many spiritual leaders he listens to or sermons that he listens to by other Pastors. He will always know that his true weekly anointed leading, guidance and words of life will primarily come from his own covering; the vision of his own church, from his own Pastor. (Pastors of churches have different visions and teaching focuses therefore they will sometimes have different rhema words delivered for only their congregations). Be aware of this wisdom.
10. God will give True Leaders prosperity in every area of life and he will give him a good name and influence.

True Leadership

1. Is a mindset.
2. Dictates one's motivation.
3. Is revealed in one's response to his environment.
4. Is the perception of oneself to the world.
5. Is one's belief system which controls his behavior.
6. Determines how other people treat you and how the world will respond to you.
7. Is your mental conditioning.

Know who you are and whose you are. If you carry low self-esteem- it will manifest in low valuation of humanity.

Unfortunately many in this world know others-worth, but no self-worth at all.

True Leaders spend their entire lives giving others value. They give people hope and a cause, a reason for living and reason for continuing. Moreover, as True leaders value themselves, they value the significance of others. (Everything in the heavens and the earth can be replaced except a soul- the worth of a soul is invaluable)

Remember you can't give significance, if you don't have it yourself (Mark 12:29,30). (Love and think highly of yourself too) Rom 12:3 kjv For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think, but to think soberly, according as God has dealt to every man The Measure of Faith.(Notice: it did not say to not think highly but not to think more highly than ye ought.)

True leaders must make a lifelong commitment to develop every element of divine character in his or her own life so he will safely reflect upon others, what he will then truly believe about himself.

The greatest discovery in life is self-discovery. Ask God to show you - you. He will do it so you can see, there will be much work to be done. The best way to know you is to know the attributes of God. He will be your perfect example and gauge. Ps 37:37 Mark the perfect man, behold the upright , for the end of that man is peace. (Mark or mimic, the perfect man, Jesus) (Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus: Who, being in the form of God, thought it not robbery to be equal with God- Phil 2:5,6).

Acts 10:38 kj –How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that was a that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

You will be what you believe and allow into your head and your heart

1. What you believe create your world.
2. Your beliefs create your convictions.

4. Your attitude control your perceptions.
5. Your perceptions dictate your behavior.
6. Therefore what you allow your mind to listen to will inevitably create your world, your convictions, your attitudes, your perceptions, and will ultimately dictate your behavior; what you do and how you respond in life.(Be very careful concerning what you allow your ears to hear.)

When wrong, contaminated, and defective beliefs and thoughts enter our heart, they will cause major insecurities and errors in your life.
