When preparing to give a message/facilitate/to lead prayer/lead praise and worship etc. , you must spend some quality time in prayer with God. If not no matter how many times you do it, God's presence and anointing will not be on you will always that seem like you are just starting.

We need to spend time praying in tongues.

We need to keep our spirit clean , not argue that week.

Ask God what you should teach his people. A lot of times it may be something he has already been dealing with you in your heart about. Also, sometimes the Pastor or leadership might give you a topic or theme to teach on.

We need to go over our message at least a week in advance

Make sure your opening scripture connects with your title or subtitle.

Make sure you time your message.

Don't just read to the people. Prepare, Prepare, Prepare.

Make sure your scriptures are correct and you pronounce your words, Hebrew meaning, Greek meanings correctly.

Always teach with Love, simplicity, truth, wisdom and clarity. What in the heart reaches the 'heart.

* Teach the word & scripture not your opinions, use visual & illustrations (most people are visual learners (II Timothy 4:2).

Don't use Christianese or words like (redemption or sanctification because most sinners or baby christian will not know what you are talking about. Only teach about it if you have a foundation of the meaning and example first. Just keep in mind that if an eight year old can understand what you are talking about then everyone should understand the message.

- Speak the truth in love, use words such as we and us, not you or yall. This helps the group feel as if you have experience or have to do the same.
- Teach with enthusiasm. Being enthusiastic is not a feeling but a decision. Teaching with confidence book says it is a sin to be boring. Smile, try to have fun.
- It's normal to be nervous, just teach in faith the jitters will disappear as you gain confidence after a minute of teaching. It may help to pick out an interested or friendly face in the group to talk to first, soon you will make eye contact with more people in the group.
- Sometimes after teaching the devil will tell you, you did a terrible job, maybe you did stumble or stuttered a little, just learn from your mistake. Whatever you do continue, don't stop.
- Speak with Authority. God has given you boldness and authority and you also have been given authority by that leader to speak, so walk in it.
- Be prepared, rambling happens when you are not prepared. If you want God's anointing to be present, you must spend time in prayer and preparing yourself in the word of God, allowing him to speak to you daily within the past week. 2.

- Be transparent, personable, vulnerable. Share about yourself, look at the people, make eye contact. People feel connected with you and it draws people in. Think about it if you are funny people will be relaxed and smiling. If you are stiff and nervous, the audience will be uncomfortable and holding their breath. If you are boring, they will fall asleep. So its very important to build a rapport, connection or have an ice breaker, joke, story, prop, testimony. If you enjoy yourself, the people will enjoy it.
- Dress appropriately, not revealing, not flashy, not a mini skirt,
- definitely Pray in tongues the morning or day of your message.
- Leave from home extra time so you will stay relax and don't look in a hurry.
- Do not eat a heavy meal before speaking.
- Go over your message while you are in the waiting room, not in the sanctuary or service.
- Message vs facilitating, stay true to topic. Do not go running after a rabbit.
- Be sure if possible to get into the prayer, praise and worship.
- Receive constructive criticism. Record yourself so you can see what others see.
- Stay true to your time. Don't spend time talking about your time. Smile, relax, Don't seem hurried. Don't make innuendos or trying to correct the Pastor. Never teach a topic that that Pastor or church do not believe in.
- Always keep a humble, loving and submissive spirit.

- Always use at least 2 to 3 scriptures to let every word be established.
- Always give honor to the Pastor and first lady of the church you are visiting or speaking at, then honor the pastor and first lady of your home church, that you are representing.
- Speak clearly, speak up, use illustrations, props, stories, testimonies speak from the heart
- Did you stay with the subject, stop timely, didn't over use some phrases or word. Did the message draw others to the Lord. Was there manners that needed to be avoided.
- **Protocol:**
- First give honor to God, the Pastor, First Lady, Elders, Members, friends and family. (this shouldn't go past 5 minutes)
- Open with prayer (HS have his way, serve Satan notice, pray everyone will be a doer of the word of God, you decrease, God increase)
- Title
- Opening Scripture
- Body
- In conclusion share last scripture, topic or note
- Let's give God a great big hand praise for the word he has given us on today.
